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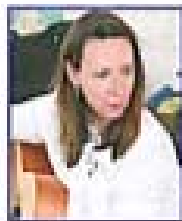

What made you set up the nanny club?

I run three Montessori nursery schools and Paint Pots House, where parents and carers come for activity classes. Many of the children are accompanied by nannies, au pairs and house-keepers, and I came up with the idea as a professional and social forum for them, because the job can be quite isolated.

What do you discuss and do?

There are lighter topics, like where to get cheap resources and how to get Ribena out of the carpet! But there's also more serious things like how to have a good relationship with your boss.

How long have you been going?

It's fortnightly and we've been going since September – we've got a regular group of 12 now. It's an opportunity to give support to carers and to explore upscaling their training and also a social outlet. They're planning to all go to see the film 'The Nanny Diaries' soon.
